### How is the biblical calendar determined?

There are two main components in the determination of the biblical calendar. The beginning of the year is based on the state of the grain, i.e., barley, in the land of Israel and the first visible new moon crescent. Since Yahweh commands His people to observe or watch for the new moon crescent, believers ought to confirm the crescent within their own land (e.g., U.S. believers should confirm it within the Continental United States).

Scriptural evidence for these principles is found in Exodus 9:31, Exodus 12:2, and Deuteronomy 16:1, along with other passages. In Exodus 9:31, while Israel was in Egypt, the Bible confirms that the barley was in the ear (Hebrew, Abib) before the first biblical month. Abib is Hebrew, literally meaning, "young ears of grain," and refers to a specific stage of barley. Exodus 12:2 verifies that the new moon following the Abib barley confirmation marks the first biblical month. In addition, Deuteronomy 16:1 confirms that we are to observe the month. We do this through observation of the new moon crescent and not calculation, as the modern Jewish calendar is determined today.
